Anyone is welcome to submit a float design concept for the South Pasadena Rose Parade Float! Your submission must be postmarked by Friday, Jan. 22, 5 pm, 2010. The design sketch must be black and white, in pencil or pen on paper no larger than 8.5" X 11". No color sketches or oversize paper entries will be considered. You may submit as many concepts as you like. Remember, this is the "concept" stage, so just a simple pencil drawing will do. You may include a short written description of the drawing and what you are trying to express. Design concepts will be judged based on relevance to the parade theme, practicality and popular appeal. If your concept is chosen you will be contacted. We hope you will be a part of next year's float – the oldest self-built float in the parade!
